Sealed tenders valid for one eighty (180) days from the date of opening are invited for SAN Storage from the reputed vendors for the new unified SAN Storage System for the disaster recovery with the following configuration/ feature :

- (a) It should be latest and able to replicate (storage based replication) the existing SAN storage at primary site. Primary site Storage is EMC Clarion CX4-120 SAN Storage.
- (b) The usable capacity of storage should be 10TB with 15 K RPM FC Disks.
- (c) The Replication Software and License for primary and new storage.
- (d) Hardware required for FCIP replication should be provided at both sites.
- (e) SAN Switch (8 Port) – Qty – 2 (f) Implementation and warranty terms.
- (f) It should seamlessly integrate with the existing SAN Storage System and be further expandable.

Delhi High Court reserves its right to cancel the ‘Tender’ without assigning any reasons (s) thereof.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The tenderer(s) must have experience of minimum 03 years in Government / Public Sector Undertakings dealing with similar type of project in respective fields and must be OEM authorized or channel partner and have not been issued any black listed letters from any Government department or PSU.
2. Relevant documentary evidence and confirmation regarding above must be enclosed, duly flagged and numbered failing which the tenderer (s) shall stand disqualified.
3. Rates offered in the Tender will not be enhanced during the period of contract.
4. The rates finally approved/accepted by the High Court of Delhi shall be valid for the whole of the contract tenure and no upward revision will be allowed under any circumstances whatsoever.
5. Under no circumstances, shall the successful firm appoint any sub-contractor or sub-lease the contract. If it is found that the contractor has violated these conditions, the contract will be terminated forthwith without any notice, by the authority who has approved the award of the contract.
6. The contract can be terminated by the competent authority at any time without assigning any reason if the work of the contractor is found unsatisfactory. Decision of the competent authority will be final and binding on the contractor. Delhi High Court reserves the right to accept or reject any bid in whole or in part without assigning any reasons thereof.
