In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the Delhi High Court Act, 1966 read with Article 225 of the Constitution of India, Clause 27 of Letters Patent and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the High Court of Delhi, hereby makes the following amendment in Part A of Chapter 5 of Volume V of the Delhi High Court Rules & Orders :-

AMENDMENT

THE FOLLOWING EXPLANATION SHALL BE INSERTED IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE EXISTING RULE 2 OF PART A OF CHAPTER 5 OF VOLUME V OF THE DELHI HIGH COURT RULES & ORDERS :-

“Explanation : In criminal cases, the term ‘parties’ shall be deemed to include the complainant and / or victim as defined under Section 2 (y) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Section 2 (wa) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973).”

NOTE: THIS AMENDMENT SHALL COME INTO FORCE FROM THE DATE OF ITS PUBLICATION IN THE GAZETTE.
