Notes:

1. The above recommendations are subject to outcome of WP(C) Nos. 5200/2018, 5240/2018 and other connected matters pending in Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.
2. 'Pass' Remarks mean such candidates are kept in panel for a period of one year from the date of declaration of result, for consideration against future vacancies.
3. 'Subject to' condition(s) mentioned with 'Pass' remarks are required to be complied with only upon receipt of communication from this Court, if and when his/her candidature is considered against future vacancies.
4. Reserved category candidates who are selected on their own merit are not adjusted against reserved vacancies. However, when a relaxed standard is applied in selecting reserved category candidates, e.g., age-limit, marks etc., such candidates are considered/counted against reserved vacancies only as they are deemed as unavailable for consideration against unreserved vacancies.
5. The cases of tie of marks have been resolved by applying the following methods one after another - (i) Total Marks in Stage-II, i.e., Main (Descriptive) Examination; (ii) Date of Birth, i.e., the candidate older in age gets preference over younger in age; and (iii) Alphabetical order of the names.
