

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 122 and 129 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 and Section 7 of the Delhi High Court Act, 1966 (Act 26 of 1966) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the High Court of Delhi, hereby makes the following amendment in the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 1967 :-

A new Chapter X-A will be added after Chapter -X.

CHAPTER X-A

Evidence on Commission at Court's discretion

Commissions to examine parties & witnesses – Notwithstanding anything contained in Order XXVI of the Code of Civil Procedure 1908, the Court may, at its discretion, in any suit, at any stage, direct that the parties and witnesses be examined on Commission. The evidence recorded on Commission shall be read as evidence in the suit.

This amendment shall come into force immediately on the date of their publication in the Delhi Gazette.
